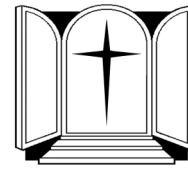

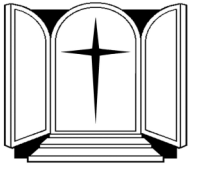

This year, six people representing thousands of missionaries serving throughout the United States, Canada and their territories are spotlighted. The other two days focus on ways Southern Baptists are reaching the lost in North America.

Day 1: Scott and Karen Blanchard, Clinton Township, Michigan

Scott is a church planter and pastor of Lakepointe Church, near Detroit.

Day 2: Ara and Anet Torosian, Burbank, California

Ara is a church planter and pastor of Armenian Fellowship of Burbank reaching Armenian and Farsi-speaking people.

Day 3: Patrick and Archalena Coats, Miami, Florida

Patrick is church planter and pastor of Kingdom Covenant Baptist Church and works with the Florida Baptist Convention's Urban Impact Ministries Team.

Day 4: Andrew Mann, Bronx, New York

Andrew is a church planter and the executive director and pastor of Graffiti 2 Church and Community Ministries.

Day 5: Lucas Aube, Sherbrook, Quebec Canada

Lucas is a church planter and pastor of Encounter Church outside Montréal, Canada. His church focuses on reaching students Bishops University and Champlain College.

Day 6: Jose and Mayra Nater, Baltimore, Maryland

Jose is a church planter and pastor of Primera Iglesia Bautista Cambridge.

Day 7: Growing the next generation of missionaries

Having enough missionaries to support Southern Baptists' efforts to impact lostness in North America will require intentionality in developing the next generation of missionaries. 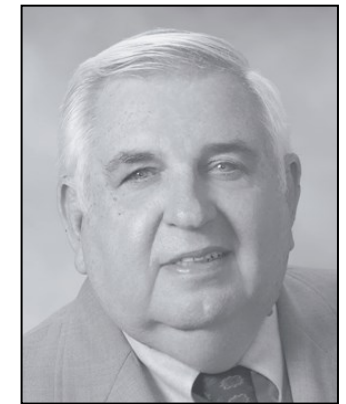
