Believers Give II Corinthians 8:1-6

The basic Christian habit of giving is always a product of our relationship with God. You see that connection between giving and relationship clearly in II Corinthians 8. No problem the Macedonians were experiencing was greater than their relationship with God.

The most important words in this passage are in verse 5:

*They first gave themselves _____,
and then to us by the will of God.*

Remember these three words about giving:

1. Attitude—joyful giving always outshines the size of the gift.
2. _____. “Want to” is always better than “have to.”
3. _____. Paul was talking less about their grace than he was talking about God’s grace being visible in their lives.
