


WEDNESDAY NIGHT PICK-UP CHANGE: In an effort to keep our children safe, we need to make changes to our pick-up procedures on Wednesday Nights. Beginning September 6, children will need to be picked up at the South End of the Fellowship Hall at the covered entrance. Every child will have to be checked out by either following the directions and pulling to the covered entrance to pick up your child(ren) or by coming into the Fellowship Hall and signing out your child(ren). No child should leave unless signed out by one of our workers in the Fellowship Hall. We appreciate your understanding and know that you are happy that FBC Geneva places a high priority on the safety of your children.



Security Policy: Because we are committed to the safety of all children in our care, we have a policy that all adults who work with our children in any capacity must have a background check completed. I will be contacting all of our new workers to get the forms completed. These have to be renewed every two years as well so I'll be contacting those that are up for renewal

soon too. Thank you to all who are so generous with your time, talents, and resources in working with our children. You are so very much appreciated and we want to do everything possible to encourage you to continue as a volunteer. As a 7-year-old in Mongolia, Jargalmaa (pictured left) described one particular day as "unexpected." After school, her teacher invited her to a church where she received her very first gift! This Operation Christmas Child shoebox gift included, among other fun toys, stationery, and a set of hairclips. Inside, she also found a letter that said, "You are valuable and so loved by God." Jargalmaa cherished this message because her parents and grandparents had never told her that they loved her.

Jargalmaa went on to participate in The Greatest Journey discipleship program where she especially appreciated the lessons about God as Creator. Later in 10th grade, she accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior. Through her testimony, five of her family members and two close friends also made this life-changing decision.

Now15 years after receiving her shoebox gift, Jargalmaa, her husband, and two young children (pictured above) have recently moved to a new community where they are ministering to youth in hopes of starting a church.

"I would like to challenge people who are preparing shoebox gifts to also write a letter showing God's love," Jargalmaa said. "What's written there may be very simple, but those simple words could completely change somebody's life."


